Subject: <u>ACTION</u>: ADA/AOA Review – Remote Identification of Unmanned Aircraft

Systems - Final Rule

Attached for your review and concurrence is the final rule, Remote Identification of Unmanned Aircraft Systems.

This rule finalizes the Remote Identification of Unmanned Aircraft Systems Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NPRM) published on December 31, 2019. The remote identification of unmanned aircraft systems in the airspace of the United States will address safety, national security, and law enforcement concerns regarding the further integration of these aircraft into the airspace of the United States, while also enabling greater operational capabilities.

This rule is a significant regulatory action pursuant to Executive Order 12866 and thus will be reviewed by the Office of Information and Regulatory Affairs (OIRA).
